

CHÂTEAU DE MUZOT

The home of the poet Rainer Maria Rilke from 1921 to 1926, the Château de Muzot is a private building surrounded by mystery and symbolism.

Carefully-sited among vineyards and orchards, the Château de **Muzot** dates from the 13th century.

Rainer Maria Rilke spent the last five years of his life here, and produced various works, including the collection of poems « Vergers » (« Orchards ») and the famous « Quatrains valaisans ».
